



## Warre's

Founded in 1670, Warre's is the oldest British Port House and has remained a family-owned company throughout its long history.

The backbone of Warre's Ports are made at Quinta da Cavadinha in the Pinhão valley, and at the historic vineyard of Quinta do Retiro Antigo in the Rio Torto valley.

Recently, the magnificent Quinta da Telhada in the far eastern stretches

of the Douro has been acquired for Warre's and provides some of its finest grapes.

The winery at Cavadinha is one of the most specialised small 'boutique' wineries, in the Douro with six state-of-the-art automated lagares. This winery is featured in Hugh Johnson's World Atlas of Wine.

In addition, some of Warre's finest Ports come from the privately family-owned vineyards of Alvito and Netas.
