Our Hambledon Blanc de Blancs Non Vintage is produced exclusively from our own estate on the South East facing chalk slopes of Windmill Down, in the historic village of Hambledon.



Hambledon's sunny, south-facing vineyards sit on a very deep seam of ancient chalk, which provides the perfect environment for producing great Chardonnay, just as it does in Champagne, and the creation of our Blanc de Blancs, made from some of our best Chardonnay grapes, allows us to put the spotlight on this outstanding English Sparkling wine style.

This first release of our Hambledon Classic Cuvée Blanc de Blancs uses the superb 2018 vintage as its base. It has been maturing in our cool cellars on its lees for more than four years, growing in complexity and balance all the while. Once in the glass, there is an immediate sensation of freshness, full of the orchard fruit aromas that are so typical of Hambledon. On the palate, the quality of the Chardonnay fruit shines through, with lovely notes of creamy apple and quince, and enhanced by the delicious scents and textures of brioche and subtle vanilla which have been created by the extended time spent ageing in bottle before release. The marriage of all the flavours last right through the palate before the wine finishes on a ripple of vivacity, which is the hallmark of all the best English Sparkling wines.
