

FLAGSHIP WHITE BLEND (GVB) 2015

ORIGIN

The Semillon was planted in 1991 on the south facing Korhaan flats at 220 m above sea level. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes used in this blend come from the 26 year old Schaapenberg Vineyard. This single vineyard is planted some 320 m above sea level and directly south facing. The row direction is east-west and the vineyards are planted to 2 clones, 316 and 317. Both from the Loire Valley.

VINIFICATION

Both Semillon and Sauvignon grapes were hand-picked, the Semillon a week after the Sauvignon, whole bunch pressed and barrel fermented. Harvesting dates were 16 and 25th February respectively. The Semillon was fermented in 25% new Francois Frere barrels and the Sauvignon in old 500 I barrels new. The wines were matured for 9 months before being bottled on 21 December 2015. Released June 2018 (still to be confirmed but likely).

COMPOSITION

Sémillon 40% Schaapenberg Sauvignon Blanc 60%

ANALYSIS

Al: 14.5 % RS 2.3 g/l TA 6.4 g/l Ph 3.19

MATURATION

Drink now or up to a decade after the vintage.

TASTING NOTE

Tight, focused and beautifully integrated with herbal(fynbos), grapefruity flavours, ripe tropical notes and a long, focused aftertaste. Enjoy with fresh seafood.
