



OUR WINE TAKES ITS NAME FROM VICTORIA PARK, WHICH THE FIRST SETTLERS CARVED OUT OF THE RUGGED BUSHLANDS OF ADELAIDE IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA. NAMED AFTER PRINCESS VICTORIA BEFORE BEING CROWNED QUEEN, THE PARKLANDS ARE A PART OF COLONEL WILLIAM LIGHT'S 1837 VISION FOR THE CITY. A POPULAR PLACE FOR RELAXATION AND MOMENTS WITH FRIENDS, IT HAS BECOME AFFECTIONATELY KNOWN AS THE PEOPLE'S PARK. TASTING COMMENTS

The grapes for this premium wine have been sourced from sustainably managed vineyards within South Australia. This Cabernet Sauvignon is deep purple in colour. The palate is true to its variety, elegantly structured with layers of flavour reminiscent of dark berries, chocolate and spice. With a smooth silky texture and soft tannin finish, this wine matches perfectly with beef fillet or roast lamb.
