



OUR WINE TAKES ITS NAME FROM VICTORIA PARK, WHICH THE FIRST SETTLERS CARVED OUT OF THE RUGGED BUSHLANDS OF ADELAIDE IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA. NAMED AFTER PRINCESS VICTORIA BEFORE BEING CROWNED QUEEN, THE PARKLANDS ARE A PART OF COLONEL WILLIAM LIGHT'S 1837 VISION FOR THE CITY. A POPULAR PLACE FOR RELAXATION AND MOMENTS WITH FRIENDS, IT HAS BECOME AFFECTIONATELY KNOWN AS THE PEOPLE'S PARK.

## TASTING COMMENTS

The grapes for this premium wine have been sourced from sustainably managed vineyards within South Australia. This Shiraz is deep crimson red in colour, with fresh plums and subtle vanilla oak with hints of violets and floral aromas. The generous silky palate has blueberry and plum fruits flavours, complimented by soft, supple tannins with hints of milk chocolate and warm spices. Bright fruit flavoues linger during the long succulet finishA perfect match for spicy lamb cutlets or a rich casserole.
